

IPWSO was established in 1991. Since then, we have supported and connected national PWS associations, as well as people with PWS, their families and the professionals who work with them.

Forty-seven national PWS associations make up our current membership and we support individuals in over seventy other countries. While we are proud of our heritage and recognise that some people with PWS now achieve far better outcomes than were believed possible in the past, we are acutely aware that people with PWS and their families continue to face serious challenges, particularly in countries where knowledge is limited



Caregiver Delegates

Caregiver Delegates are the point of contact that IPWSO's Professional Provider Caregiver Board (PPCB) uses to distribute information about residential support. Caregiver Delegates are appointed by their country's PWS Association.

At present, IPWSO has 12 appointed Caregiver Delegates, in Australia, Austria, Denmark, Ireland, Japan, the Netherlands, New Zealand, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, UK, and USA.


