

#### RESEARCH QUESTION

What are the **lived experiences** of **expatriate parents** in Qatar with one or more children who have disabilities?

#### FINDINGS: COMMON THEMES

THEME 1:  Managing the diagnosis is grueling	THEME 2: Lack of information is debilitating	THEME 3: Therapy support is severely lacking	THEME 4: My child needs an education	
Struggle for diagnosis	No central information resource	The cookie-cutter model	No school will accept my child	Prohibitive financial policies and practices
I have a diagnosis now what?	Mothers become researchers extraordinaire	The financial burden of foundational therapies	No transition into mainstream	Lack of legislative support

15% – 420% families' income




