

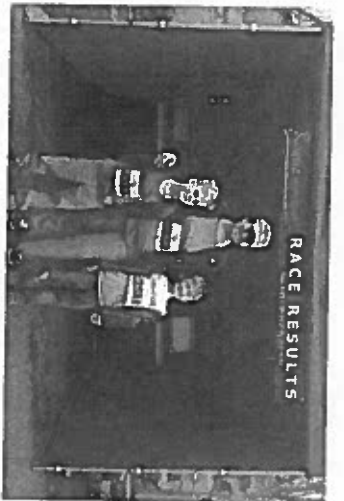

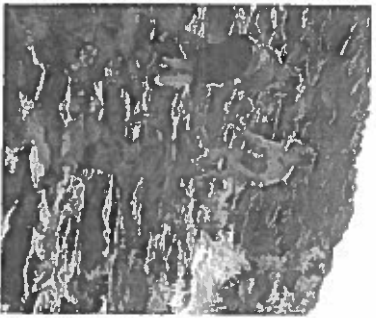

WHAT HELPS CAINAN
